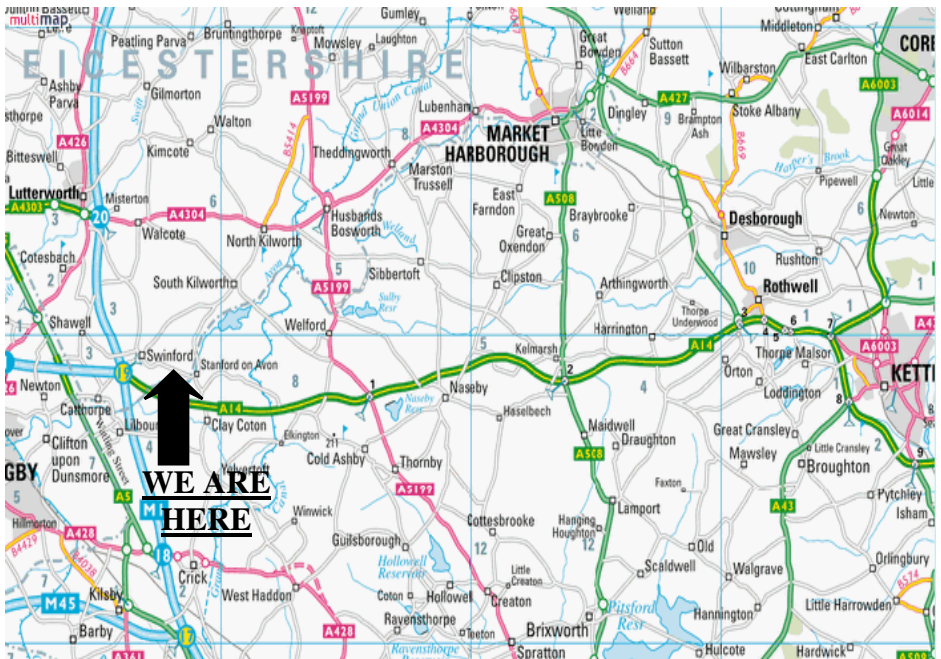

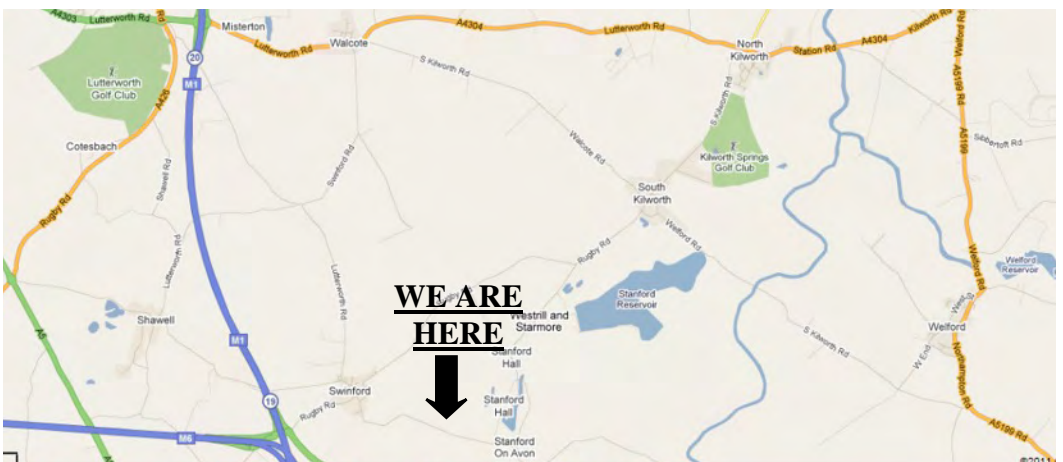

RING 1

**PLEASE NOTE CLASSES 2 & 3 WILL BE RUN UNDER SINGLE PHASE
CLASSES 1,4,5, & 6 RUN UNDER TABLE A7
SHOW JUMPING FOR HORSES & PONIES
COMMENCING AT 9.30 am PROMPT**

CLASS 1: 2ft JUMPING -OPEN TO HORSE & PONY (Rising to 2FT)
Results will be split into Horse & Pony

CLASS 2: 2ft3 JUMPING -OPEN TO HORSE & PONY(Rising to 2ft3)
Results will be split into Horse & Pony

CLASS 3: 2ft6 JUMPING -OPEN TO HORSE & PONY(Rising to 2ft6)
Results will be split into Horse & Pony

THE FOLLOWING CLASSES WILL NOT START BEFORE 1.00pm

Classes 4,5 AND 6 will have the 1st round timed at 325mpm

CLASS 4: 2ft9 JUMPING -OPEN TO HORSE & PONY(Rising to 2ft9)
Results will be split into Horse & Pony

CLASS 5: 3ft JUMPING - OPEN TO HORSE & PONY(Rising to 3ft)
Results will be split into Horse & Pony

CLASS 6: OPEN JUMPING HORSE & PONY
Results will NOT be split

* Horses & Ponies entered in Ring 1 classes will compete, except where stated, within their respective groups I.E. Horses 1st - 6th Ponies 1st - 6th

* Ponies classed as 14.2hh and under Horses as over 14.2hh

* If competing in class 1 that combination may NOT enter classes 4, 5 or 6

* Competitors from Ring 2 may compete in class 1 only, but then CANNOT compete in Beginner's Jumping for the rest of the season

* Horses/Ponies may enter a MAXIMUM of 3 Show jumping classes

* Any horse/rider combination entered in classes 4, 5, 6 may NOT enter class 1 at any show

* All riders must wear a show jacket and number at all times whilst in the show jumping ring.

ENTRY FEES: MEMBERS : £5 NON - MEMBERS £7

What is single phase jumping? This is a course of around 12/14 fences, you jump your normal 6/7 fences, then you carry on straight into the jump off irrelevant of faults gained over first part. Though you are only timed in the jump off phase of the course. We are doing this to enable competitors with faults (unless eliminated) or not to jump a jump off course, plus aid us in getting through classes quicker to give less waiting time between classes and save you missing showing classes due to waiting for a jump off! TABLE A7 - This is normal first round of about 10 fences which everyone jumps and a separate jump off

RING 2

12 YEARS AND UNDER JUMPING

STARTS 10 AM PROMPT

If you are jumping in Ring 2 then you CANNOT enter any Class in ring 1 with the exception of class 1.

Any rider competing in class 7 & 8 may NOT compete in class 13

You may only jump 3 Classes plus the fun classes.

Class will be split into lead rein and Non lead rein

CLASS 8: 1ft6 BEGINNERS JUMPING(may be led)

CLASS 9: 1ft6 FUN CLASS (may be led)

- 2) THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO ALTER OR CANCEL ANY CLASS, REFUSE ENTRY, WITHHOLD A PRIZE OR DISQUALIFY A COMPETITOR AT ANY TIME AND FOR ANY REASON THEY DEEM SUFFICIENT.
- 3) ANY MISUSE OF A WHIP, FAILURE TO OBEY AN ORDER FROM A JUDGE, STEWARD OR COMMITTEE MEMBER, DISCOURTEOUS BEHAVIOUR TO ANY OTHER SHOW GROUND PERSONNEL MAY RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM THE SHOW GROUND.
- 4) NEITHER THE ORGANISERS OR LAND OWNERS ACCEPT ANY LIABILITY FOR ANY ACCIDENT, INJURY OR ILLNESS TO ANY ANIMAL, SPECTATOR, OTHER PERSONS OR PROPERTY WHATSOEVER.
- 5) THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CANCEL OR POSTPONE THE SHOW AT SHORT NOTICE IN THE EVENT OF ADVERSE CONDITIONS.
- 6) ANY OBJECTIONS OR COMPLAINTS MUST BE MADE IN WRITING AND LODGED WITH THE CHAIRMAN WITHIN 30 MINUTES OF AN ALLEGED INCIDENT. IT MUST BE ACCOMPANIED WITH £10 WHICH WILL BE REFUNDED IF THE COMPLAINT IS UPHOLD.

- 9) COMPETITORS MUST WEAR CORRECT FOOTWEAR WHEN MOUNTED, NO PUMPS, TRAINERS OR SHOES.
- 10) SHOW JACKETS MUST BE WORN WHEN SHOW JUMPING
- 11) THE COMMITTEE STRONGLY RECOMMEND THE USE OF BODY PROTECTORS
- 12) HARD HATS WITH CORRECTLY FITTING CHIN STRAPS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED TO BE BS EN 1384 OR PAS 015
- 13) NO WHIPS OR SPURS IN THE GYMKHANA RING. NO SPURS IN RING 2
- 14) ANY COMPETITOR ENTERED IN THE 12 YEARS & UNDER RING MAY NOT COMPETE IN THE MAIN JUMPING RING WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CLASS 1
- 15) ALL RIDDEN ANIMALS ARE TO BE 4 YEARS OR OVER
- 16) DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES
- 17) MEMBERSHIP CARDS MUST BE SHOWN AT THE ENTRIES TENT TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS AND MEMBERS DISCOUNT FOR THAT SHOW
